Leonardo DiCaprio is a famous American actor and film producer. He was born on November 11, 1974, in Los Angeles, California. His mother, Irmelin, was a legal secretary, and his father, George DiCaprio, was a comic book writer and distributor. As a child, Leonardo showed interest in acting and began appearing in television commercials at a young age.

At the age of five, he got his first role in a children's TV show. Later, he attended the Los Angeles Center for Enriched Studies but eventually focused more on acting. In the early 1990s, he starred in TV series like *Growing Pains*, which helped him gain recognition.

In 1993, DiCaprio played a major role in *What's Eating Gilbert Grape*, earning his first Academy Award nomination. However, it was his role in *Titanic* (1997) that made him a global superstar. Over the years, he worked with famous directors like Martin Scorsese and Quentin Tarantino, starring in hit movies such as *Inception*, *The Wolf of Wall Street*, and *The Revenant*. In 2016, he won his first Academy Award for Best Actor for his role in *The Revenant*.

DiCaprio is also known for his environmental activism. He established the Leonardo DiCaprio Foundation, which focuses on wildlife conservation and climate change awareness.
